FINISHER'S MISSIONARY HOUSE | LOCAL

The City of San Antonio is projecting over 1 million new people to flood into the city and surrounding areas within the next 10-15 years. To answer this growing need for discipleship, Gateway Fellowship will continue to ramp up its efforts to train and release new campus pastors.

CHURCH PLANT WESTSIDE

CHURCH PLANT | LYTLE

Many times when you think of planting a church, the first thing that comes to mind is a building, then the people that will fill it. However, Brandon and Kim Smith saw things differently—their first thought was the people before the building.

In January 2018, while listening to the pastor's message about answering the call of God to "be SENT." Brandon heard God tell him, "It's time."

Brandon and Kim have lived most of their lives in the Lytle area. There they are raising their family and living in a wonderful community, which is built around family values and strong relationships; but the key ingredient which was missing in their community was a strong relationship with God. Sixty percent of this 100,000 person community is unchurched. Among the believers there is little true discipleship that is happening.

As farmers, Brandon and Kim understand, the need for rich furtive soil to produce a healthy crop. So they quickly signed up for H300 small group leader training in June 2018. During their training to lead a small group they heard about the starting of The Gateway School of Ministry in September 2018. As they finished their training for small groups and launched their own small group, they also began a 15 month intensive hands on ministry training through the Gateway School of Ministry.

Brandon had known from an early age that God was calling him to be a pastor. Even with their very busy lives and

enormous responsibilities on the farm, Brandon and Kim decided to be obedient to the call of God and be trained as lead pastors in planting a church in the Lytle area. The last two years have been a whirlwind of learning, growing and stretching their faith in God, yet the Lord has been by their sides throughout and proven Himself every step of the way. Through one on one relational discipleship and pouring their lives into others, leaders have risen up to join with Brandon and Kim in answering the call to become disciple makers. Their one small group has multiplied into three thriving small groups placed in key areas of this farming community.

One of the greatest things God has taught them through farming is that the "harvest has a short window before it's gone." It's the same with the harvest of souls, you need laborers ready to go into the field, to reap the harvest.

God is building a team of believers who have a vision and a heart for this community to be transformed.

The Lytle church is launching Spring of 2021 and we are excited to see how God will move in the Lytle community. As Kingdom Builders we are grateful for the privilege to support the work of the ministry, and we know God will use our sacrificial giving to bring a harvest of souls for the Kingdom.


LOCAL OUTREACH AND CHURCH PLANTING

"I know the plans that I have for you," says the Lord.

In August of 2013, as Jose Miguel Ocampo was preparing his move from Mexico to San Antonio, Texas, to attend UTSA, he had no idea how significantly the trajectory of his life would change over the course of the next 8 years.

While on campus, in the first weeks of school, a new friendship would soon be the bridge to the plan God had for his life. Jose Miguel received an invite to attend a special Chi Alpha (Christian Fellowship) service.

Jose Miguel began meeting many students from Chi Alpha who loved God with all their hearts and were passionate about sharing the gospel with anyone that would listen. Jose Miguel initially thought, "hey, they are cool and I can meet some people and have some fun." Each event brought him closer to the cross and the realization of who Jesus was.

After attending several small group

meetings and starting to build a friendship with Fabio (his small group leader) but still going out partying and continuing his life lost in sin, Jose Miguel had an encounter with God.

Early in the morning, Jose Miguel woke up from a drunken stupor completely terrified. He had a dream, a vision of Hell and he was going there because he didn't receive the gift of God through faith and the repentance of sin. He called Fabio at 3am, crying and asking what he must do to be saved.

That morning, he totally surrendered his life to Jesus, and began learning how to love God and to walk with Him daily.

He hasn't looked back since. In January 2014, Jose Miguel's hunger for God was quickly evident and he began intense discipleship training to become a XA small group leader

Over the last 7 years, Jose Miguel has faithfully been a member of Gateway Fellowship church. He has served his way to leadership in many areas from set up and tear down team at the movie theater, parking lot team, teaching in Adventure Kids, to training future small group leaders and GSM students.

At the same time his love and passion for Jesus has continued to burn bright as he has served the students of UTSA by being a small group leader for 3 years until he graduated with a B.A. in Communication, to then becoming a full time XA missionary. Jose Miguel's heart to continue the same mission of reconciling students to Jesus Christ has been steadfast.

As a SON of the HOUSE, we are extremely excited to partner with Jose Miguel in a new season as we send him out to plant a new Chi Alpha at the University of Arizona.

In the Spring of 2019, God confirmed in Jose Miguel's heart to answer the call to "GO" to U of A to meet the spiritual need of over 45,000 students that have very little Gospel witness.

We know that the last 7 years of learning God's heart for the lost and training under the leadership of XA UTSA and Gateway Fellowship Church, that our brother is ready to go to the harvest fields of U of A to begin the work of reconciling their diverse student population back to God.

The sacrificial love offering toward this new XA Campus Ministry will reap spiritual dividends that we will only fully know when we get to heaven.

Just like Jose Miguel's story, Jesus has plans for the students of U of A. He wants them to gain the knowledge of Him as Savior and Lord.









CONVOY OF HOPE

In the midst of any tragedy— Convoy of Hope will be there.

This was true for us in our own community. When stay-at-home orders and business closures were mandated, Convoy of Hope's partnership was vital in reaching the families in the communities around us.

The food donations from Convoy of Hope enabled us to feed over 1,200 families at the beginning of the pandemic.

In May, Convoy of Hope reached out again to partner with Gateway Fellowship Church. Together, with the Lytle church plant and 17 other local community partners, we were able to get food into the hands of 1000 needy families.

In August, Convoy of Hope responded to the needs in Lake Charles resulting from the devastation left behind from Hurricane Laura. The storm left nearly a million people without power, hundreds of thousands with water system outages, and countless homes and businesses damaged or destroyed. Teams from within our church family and XA students loaded up with chainsaws, lawn equipment and sleeping bags to aid the efforts to support the people in Lake Charles. **Partnership with Convoy of Hope** and other churches in the area made it possible to serve nearly 27,000 people with relief supplies.

This year, we are asking our Kingdom builders to prayerfully consider how they can financially support this ministry that has and will continue to touch so many lives when they desperately need it.





1HOPE FOR KIDS

In 1975, during the final days of the Vietnam war, Operation Babylift evacuated 3,300 children to take them to the West to be adopted. Tony was one of those children. Because his father was American, Tony's mother feared for his safety. Before she died, she asked her daughter to make sure Tony made it to America. At the age of eight, Tony left all he knew to begin a new life in a foreign land. Adopted and raised in a Christian home, he grew up with the knowledge and love of Jesus.

In 2009, Tony and his wife CoraLei would become a part of the Gateway Fellowship Church. At Gateway they were trained and became small group leaders. Tony went on to become the small group pastor, encouraging and teaching others how to be devoted followers of Jesus Christ. In 2015, Tony and

CoraLei went to Vietnam for seven months, and in 2017, he and CoraLei committed their lives to full-time missions. From Vietnam to America and back to Vietnam, God had taken Tony full circle. They were trained, and now they were being sent to preach the Gospel and baptize Vietnamese men and women in the name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit. God had sent them to do there what he had asked them to do here.

Vietnam is one of the most unreached people groups in the world. There are over 97 million people, and only 9% of them are Christian.

In this country, many people participate in ancestor worship, Buddhism, and 35% have no religious affiliation at all.



Since 2017, Tony and CoraLei have worked diligently alongside "Coffee with a Cause" and invested large amounts of time praying, teaching, and equipping Vietnamese men and women in their small group in Vietnam. Tony and CoraLei are in the United States now sharing the vision God has given them in this next season of life in reaching the lost of Vietnam. God has placed a burden on their hearts and is sending them to plant a church in Da Nang that will be a bridge between North and South Vietnam.

Tony and CoraLei are taking the next steps to learn language in preparation for planting a church in the Da Nang province to be used as a spiritual bridge between the believers of North and South Vietnam.

The harvest is plentiful, so whether you Pray, Give, or Go, your partnership is essential in furthering the kingdom of God to those living in darkness.











ON MISSION | EGYPT

10 years ago when Ted and Bethany said, "yes" to the call to GO to Egypt, it would have been a normal reaction to think, "Wow, what is your story, how did God let you know it was Egypt? Did you hear His voice, did you have a dream?" But their story of their "yes" to Egypt began with the small everyday things such as: "Will you wake up early to read my Word? Will you stay up late to pray for the lost? Will you tell those around you about Me?" Ted and Bethany saw the need was great for the Gospel to be preached in the nation of Egypt.

Egypt holds two-thirds of the world's Arab population. Over 102 billion people live in Egypt and of that population 95% are Muslims.

Egypt is considered the intellectual mind of Islam and has the oldest and largest Islamic university in the world, which graduates hundreds of Islamic missionaries each year to go into the world to spread the message of Islam.

So once again Ted and Bethany said yes, this time to a launch training team to spend a couple

years learning language and cultural training. During the time on the training team, Ted knew in his heart that Cairo was the place they would settle and lead a church plant. They would continue to build relationships and disciple new believers. Bethany on the other hand was not convinced; she loved the people and the country they were called to, but she secretly hoped and prayed that they would start a work any other place than Cairo. Certainly, she reasoned, "there are more desirable places to serve in the Arab world."

Cairo is known as being a very densely-populated, some would even say chaotic city. With over 20 million people, Cairo suffers from overcrowding, pollution, crime, poverty, traffic jams and the absence of laws; but within all these problems, it is a colorful, vibrant, cultural center for the arts and politics filled with life. During a prayer and vision trip to another Arab nation, Ted and Bethany stayed with a family that had lived in Cairo for a very short time before they decided that they couldn't work in that chaos. The word the worker said after describing their unfavorable time in the city was the whisper from God that Bethany needed.





"If someone would go live and work in that chaos, they would bear much fruit."

Those words ripped through Bethany's heart and she knew that dying to her preferences, saying "yes" once more was worth it to be obedient to the plan God had for them.

So, the "how "and "why" of Ted and Bethany going to Egypt and then to plant the church in Cairo is simple: they were invited (called) and decided to go. The Lord laid out the plans as they began walking out the mission as He always does for His children.

From the beginning of Ted and Bethany's time in Egypt they committed to proclaiming the name of Jesus early and often, which means every day they intentionally seek to reach the lost in their everyday lives whether in a taxi cab, at a chai shop or with their neighbors. By doing this they have been able to reach many people who come to know the hope that we have in Jesus and His finished work at the Cross.

Ted and Bethany's team use social media to target seekers in their region. They routinely develop ways to utilize this new cyber sowing method to reach out to those in their city and begin dialogue about Jesus and who He was. This has led to in-depth conversations about

the Gospel, and for those wanting to have deeper conversations and prayer that are leading to Muslims coming to Christ.

Those that are coming to Jesus are then being discipled and becoming a part of the local community church plant. When the world shut down due to the Pandemic, their world exploded to over 100,000 notifications a day to know more about ISA (Jesus in Arabic).

The Cairo CP Team was also able to help implement similar tools for church planting teams throughout the Arab nation.

Those that are lost and have no hope are finding their new life and hope in

Jesus. The harvest is truly ripe in Egypt, but they need more workers to join them in the field and they need more finances to meet the growing needs of reaching this nation for Jesus.

We see the hand of God in this ministry and we are very proud to join in partnership with Ted, Bethany and the Cairo team to further the work of God in this nation. It is time to rise up and take back this land for the

Kingdom of God. Our Kingdom Builders offer financial support for the work of bringing the unreached to the saving knowledge of God, in the hardest places in the world. Imagine how your sacrificial giving is changing the lives in a country whose influence is paramount to the entire nation of Islam.

PRAYER MATTERS
